

# The Dewclaw Hanger Instructions

Read all instructions and disclaimers before use. This product is only intended as a hanger and not for any other purpose.

**DO NOT** HANG GEAR FROM HANGER UNTIL IT IS COMPLETELY ASSEMBLED ON THE TREE, DOING SO WILL RESULT IN GEAR FALLING FROM THE TREE. **DO NOT** EXCEED THE SPECIFICATIONS OF THE HANGERS (8 LBS. FOR BOW HANGER, 12 LBS. PER GEAR HANGER). **INSPECT** HANGER BEFORE & AFTER EVERY USE, TO ENSURE NOTHING HAS CRACKED DURING TRANSPORTATION.



**Step 1:** Hold hanger to the tree on the side your bow will hang from, the rope locker should be facing towards you.



**Step 2:** Throw or reach around the tree with the tag end that the acorn is attached to. Go under the top portion (non-barbed side) of the rope locker.



**Step 3:** Before cinching tight, adjust your gear hooks to suit your setup. This is the easiest time to adjust the hooks because once the rope is cinched down, everything locks into the tree. Ensure that the rope is around the tree evenly and does not dip in places.



**Step 4:** Pull the tag end away from the side the hanger is on to tighten the rope (don't be afraid to really pull). Then pinch the rope with your fingers to prevent it from slipping



**Step 5:** Grab the tag end with your other hand, and bring it under the rope locker, pulling towards the side the bow hanger is on. Be sure that you don't allow the rope to slack line at all.



**Step 6:** Pull the rope back away from the hanger locking it into the barbed side of the rope locker.



**Step 7:** Push down on the top of the bow hanger to lock the hanger in (the teeth will bite in). This completes the locking process. Now you can hang your gear or bow from the whole strap. **DO NOT EXCEED 10 LBS. ON EACH HANGER**



**Step 8:** To remove the hanger reverse the locking process steps and store the gear hangers close to the bow hanger. The thickness of the rope will hold the gear hangers for storage.
